



Criteria for the WA Occupational Therapy Association Inc. research grant  
Grant valued at \$2000

Applicants must:

1. Member of the WA Occupational Therapy Association
2. Supply a detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV)
3. Supply supportive letters from two referees who may be approached for information about the applicant. Referees should be conversant with the proposed study or project
4. Outline of the proposed study. This must include the project title, aims, timelines, methods, benefits and purpose of the study. Please provide a detailed budget, explaining how the \$2000 WAOTA grant will be directly related to the cost of the study (Maximum 3 pages)
5. Ethics approval (evidence in writing) will need to be obtained before funding is approved
6. Document if receiving other sources of funding and provide rationale for further funding
7. Write a report to the Research Committee and submit an expenditure account
8. The successful applicant will be required to submit a poster or oral presentation at the WA Occupational Therapy biannual conference or Research Symposium as soon as feasible
9. Submit application attention to: Research Committee, WA Occupational Therapy Association Inc, 4A 266 Hay Street, Subiaco, WA 6008
10. Priority will be given to new investigators (Occupational Therapists who have not received national and international level grants)
11. WAOTA grant money will not be provided to fund participant incentives
12. There will be one \$2000 grant available per calendar year.
