Rural & Remote scholarship application criteria:

- Must be a current financial member of WAOTA
- Must be working more than 100km from the Perth Metropolitan area
- In maximum of 250 words, please explain the professional benefit of your attendance at this Professional Development Event
- Please provide an up-to-date Curriculum Vitae
- Agree to share knowledge with other colleagues
- Agree to write a 400 word course/workshop review article for the WAOTA newsletter in the month following the course.
- Members are eligible to receive one scholarship per calendar year.
- Sign the application as being true and correct.
